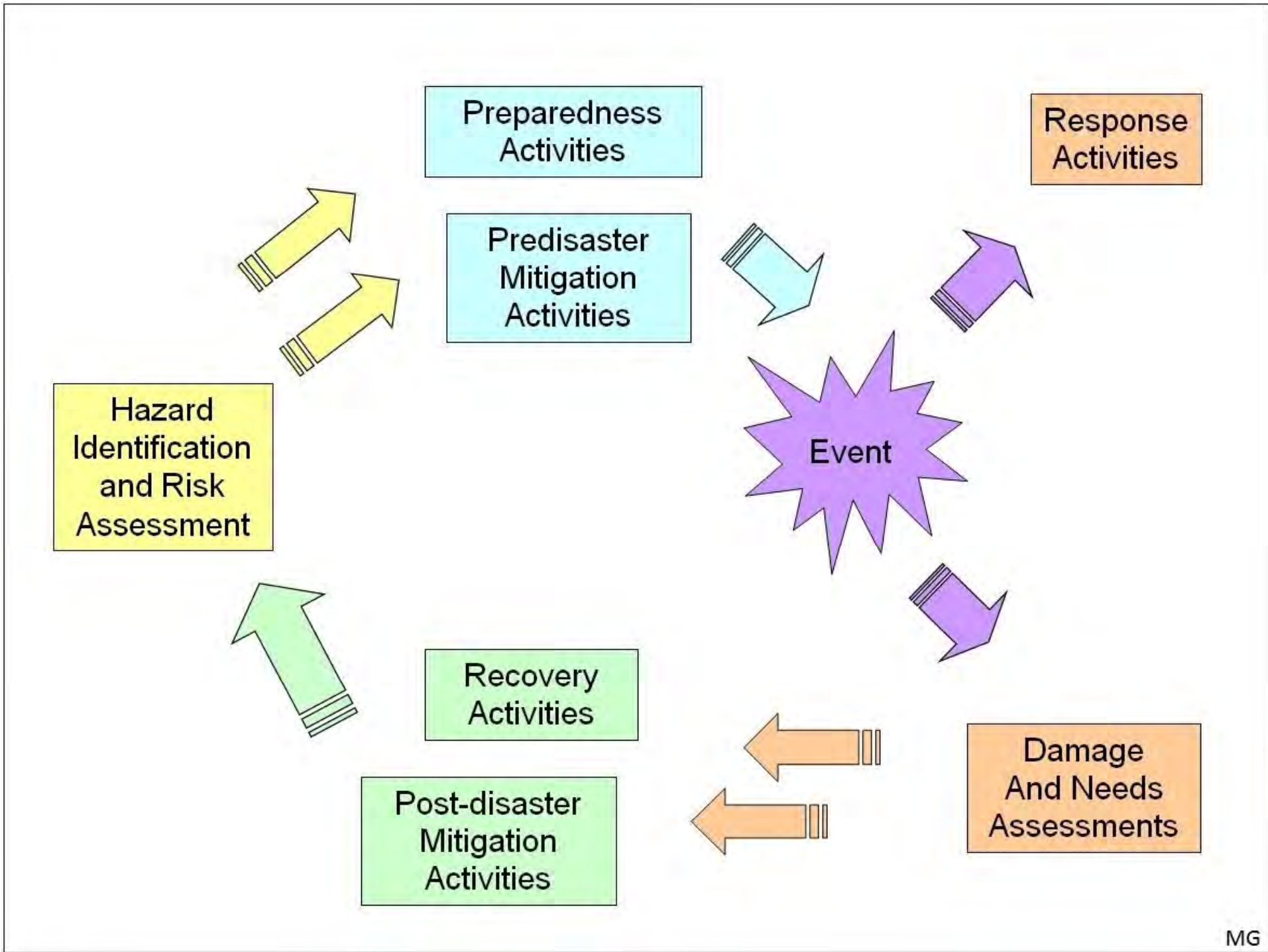

Post-Disaster Mitigation

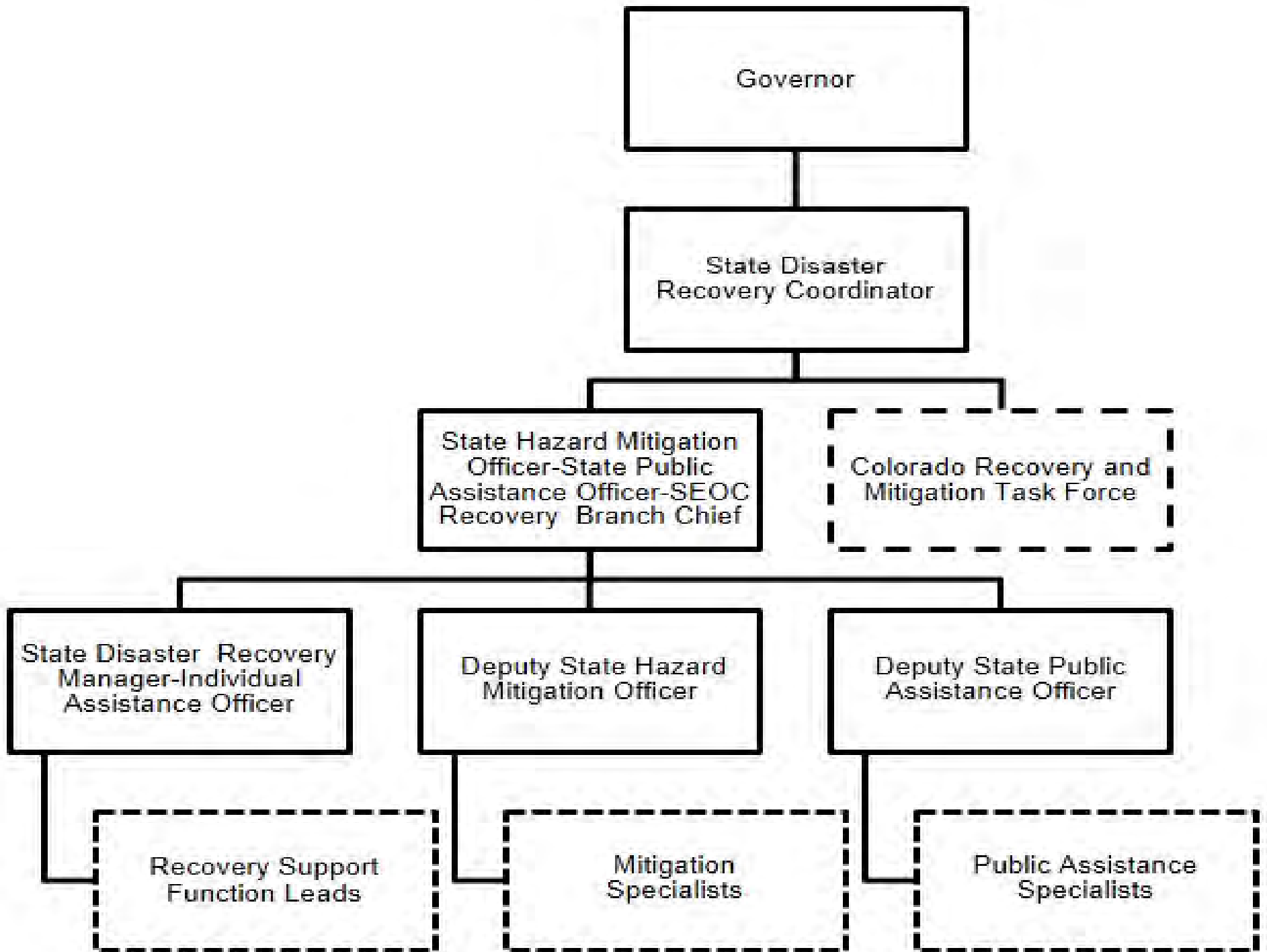
A good example of post-disaster mitigation is taking actions after a wildfire to protect people, property, and critical infrastructure from new or higher risk of debris flows and/or flooding.
